21.3.0 Release

- EMIS FN Graduate elements moved to Exemptions/Requirements
 - EMIS elements added to the Exemptions/Requirements screen for updating
 - With the exception of the Grad-Only elements, the FN graduate elements will now be maintained on the Exemptions/Requirements screen
 - Edit Profile - FN Graduate elements will be 'display only' on the profile
 - Student Profile Bulk Update, Graduation Date Ad hoc update and Diploma type Ad hoc updates will still update the elements as usual
 - A link will be added to the Edit Profile - FN Graduate tab to link over to Exemptions/Requirements screen

Ad hoc reports should still work to pull in data

21.3.0 Release

Done time in April

- EMIS GQ transfer Updated to report Graduation Seal Program Codes based on the 'Plans to earn' or 'Earned' check boxes on Graduation Requirement/Exemptions ('S' & 'G' Collections)

- When checkbox for 'Earned' is checked, a GQ record would be included in the GQ Transfer file each year until the student graduates.
- When checkbox for 'Plans to Earn' is checked, a GQ record would be included in the GQ Transfer file each year until the student graduates
- If 'Plans to Earn' + 'Earned' is checked for a seal, only the 'Earned' program code will be included
- If a seal is earned for Honors Diploma, College-Ready, and Industry-Recognized Credential Seals, there is no 'earned' program code, ODE determines 'earned' based on other data reported
- If Seal of Biliteracy is earned, 'earned' is determined by the languages selected in the Languages Proficient field

21.3.0 Release

- What will happen to graduation seal memberships *Enter as many as you are of*
 1. Districts can continue to add membership records for graduation seals 'Plans to earn' or 'Earned'
 2. When the release is installed:
 1. A script will be included to update graduation seals based on existing student Membership records for graduation seals
 2. Student Membership records for graduation seals will be deleted
 3. Membership codes for graduation seals will be removed, from that point on, all updates need to be made on the exemptions/requirements screen *you will still need to enter Membership codes for future language codes.*

Period L GN Reporting for GN150 and GN152

GN150 & GN152 – High School Credit Earned & Partial/Override Credit Elements

Student information, with approval of ODE, has handled the reporting of these elements in the following manner:

Description	GN150	GN152	Explanation
Courses that are not 'for high school credit'	Y	0	Indicates these courses do not earn high school credit
Courses that are 'for high school credit'	P	Amount of credit earned including 0 if no credit earned	ODE uses the amount of credit that is reported in the Partial/Override Credit element instead of the credit amount from the CN course master record. This is reported this way in case the amount of credit a student is awarded when the credit is different than what is reported on the course master record.

MAJORITY OF ATTENDANCE IRN

- Majority of EMIS Guidelines
 - Majority of Attendance is the IRN of the building or district where a student is continuously enrolled from the end of October Count Week through March 31.
 - Majority of attendance will never be an IRN outside of the district boundary. When the determination is made, the following rules are applied:
 - If the student was continuously enrolled in the building for the designated time period, the student's majority of attendance IRN will be equal to the building IRN
 - If the student is continuously enrolled in the district but has changed buildings in the district during the designated time period, the student's majority of attendance IRN will be equal to the district IRN
 - If the student was not continuously enrolled within the building or district during the designated time period, the student's majority of attendance IRN will be equal to "*****".
 - The resident district is responsible for reporting the Majority of Attendance IRN using the above rules for the following students:
 - CCP, Post-Secondary Institution – Sent Reason PS
 - MRDD – Sent Reason MR
 - JVS – Sent Reason JV
 - Contract Career-Technical – Sent Reason CT
 - Non-public at District Expense – Sent Reason NP
 - Attending a State School – Sent Reason - OS
 - School age ESC

MAJORITY OF ATTENDANCE IRN

- Majority of Attendance IRN Guidelines
 - The ESC is responsible for reporting the Majority of Attendance element for preschool students. Majority of Attendance fields are used for the Local Report Card, so you will want to be certain the data is as accurate as possible.
 - For students with a District Relationship of '3' who are Autism Scholarship, English Learners (LEP students) or JDC students who are at the district for the entire year, ODE will change it regardless of what you report. ODE updates the MOA IRN to '*****', and these students are counted at the State Level. See "Technical Documentation Ohio's Where Kids Count Business Rules" on ODE's website for additional information.
