CRR – Review of Process




- You should have the school year context set to 2021/2022
- When navigating to Civil Rights, you will have two options.
- Civil Rights Report (CRR) is to run a downloadable report that will show you all of your data that has been entered
- Manual Civil Rights Data Entry is the option to choose when entering data into the fields that require manual entry



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CRR – Review of Process




- When choosing the Civil Rights Report
 (CRR) option, it will bring you to this screen
- Effective date should default to 10/1/21
- Report can be run for one or multiple buildings at one time
- If a building has block scheduling the appropriate box for the building needs to be checked, and the First and Second Block Effective Dates added
- The Report Format will need to be selected. You can choose Adobe PDF or Adobe PDF & CSV; output located at Settings/Management and click on the blue link

CRR - Manual Civil Rights Data Entry Page

- Districts should complete all items that apply to each building
- For the DIND area, if it does not apply to your school, the field can be left blank
- For all other manual entry areas, schools must enter zeros if they value is zero, if the value is unknown or the value is not applicable to your school
- Note that when entering manual data, there are three areas on the selection, all need to be completed (screenshot prior page)
 - NCES School ID
 - Civil Rights
 - INET: Internet Access and Devices



CRR – Required Nonbinary valid for 2021/2022

- The Nonbinary Student Indicator is a field required for 21/22 CRR reporting
- This field was NOT included in this release
- The Element Name is SCH_NBS_IND
- Permitted values are Yes/No (these values must be spelled out) Y/N
 cannot be substituted for the Yes or for the No
- Each Building must report this value for this reporting year
- Steps for districts to use are included on the following slides



CRR – Required Nonbinary valid for 2021/2022

- The first method to add this data is as follows:
- When you pull up your .csv file, prior to submitting same to the CRDC, open the .csv file
- If you get this popup, click 'Don't Convert'



- Add the header and data value in the first empty column, then Save
- This field and data will then be included when uploading the file to the CRDC



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CRR - Required Nonbinary valid for 2021/2022

- The second method to add this data is as follows:
- This data can be entered directly into the 2021-22 CRDC data submission system. So you would go to the CRDC site, and add the data there



CRR – Created Nonbinary Gender Attributes

• A script was written to create Nonbinary Gender Attributes placing an X instead of a M or F at the end of the Attribute names that collect nonbinary gender data. If the Gender Identity field on the Profile – General tab is populated with NB-Nonbinary, this will be used for the counts. Otherwise, the Gender field value is used. Also, nonbinary gender data is not gathered for preschoolers.





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
