

ODEW EMIS-ITC Call – 03/17/2025

**FTE Detail Report** - During the previous ODEW EMIS ITC Call, we discussed a new fund pattern code (FPNA) for students who don't seem to meet any of the eligibility criteria for funding. That code is now in production and ran last weekend for the first time. Districts who have these students will now see this fund pattern code in their reports; as a reminder, this includes a very small number of students.

**Data Collector** - We are getting close to the next data collector release. Things included in this upcoming version will be discussed at the OECN conference for ITC Staff. We will have a firm date of release by the conference, if it isn't out already by that time.

**Q:** Any update on the FLUP report? We've had several districts ask.

**A:** I do not have an update; hopefully this week.

**Q:** The last update for Gen Issues reports was Feb. 24<sup>th</sup>, which is almost a month ago. Is that right?

**A:** It's hard to say. Those reports are updated by individual data managers, so I'm not aware if there have been more recent updates than that. Just a reminder, you'll only see an update if the results for one of the LEAs in your ITC have changed. It's possible there have not been any updates. It's also possible there have been updates, but none of your districts showed a change in their data. I'm not aware of things not working correctly, but we will double check.

**Q:** We have districts who have started to submit MOA fields, even though we are not to the March 31st date, and can see those reflected in the WKC reports. One district is not showing this data -it looks like they haven't submitted any MOA data, but they have. For this district, instead of reporting asterisks on the default values for Accountability IRN, they are just reporting null values. Could this cause the issue?

**A:** It definitely uses the Accountability IRN, and in processing there is a definite difference between a null and the default value we ask districts to report. Nulls can do funny things in sequel statements, so that very well could be the cause.

**Q:** I did ask the district to update and report the default value - they just did this on Friday, and I can go back and check today to see if this resolved the issue. They have null in quite a few FN records - these aren't fatal records; they do make it through the submission.

**A:** We have some fields where a null value will fatal the record, but it isn't universal in all fields. This may be something we just need to look at more closely. Thank you for the heads up.
