• After the update to the User Interface on the **Daily Attendance** screen in GradeBook v25.0.0, the first student in each column of the screen was not displayed. Now, the **Daily Attendance** screen correctly displays all students who have not been hidden by the teacher.

Student Transfer > Pending Students

(PBSIS-39658) Previously, after the removal of SSNs in v25.0.0, an error message related to SSN matching displayed on the Student Transfer > Pending Students screen for some students when users clicked Bulk Enroll District Transfer and tried to complete the bulk enroll process for the students. Now, this error message is no longer displayed.

Transcript Formatter (R702)

• The following update was implemented in StudentInformation v24.2.1 but was not included in v25.0.0 and has now been implemented in v25.0.1:

(PBSIS-37982) Previously, for newer buildings, the **Transcript Formatter** (R702) did not pull the full course history for students who were transferred in with a course history that went back more years than the building had been opened. This issue was found to be related to the **Transcript Formatter** (R702) update in StudentInformation v24.2.0 in which if no years were selected in the **School Year(s) for Marks** field on the **Search Criteria** tab, the report output would include data from the last 10 years from the selected school year in context (PBSIS-35457). Now, the changes added in v24.2.0 have been reverted, and the **Transcript Formatter** (R702) correctly pulls the full course history for students who transfer in with a course history of more years than a building has been open.

StateReporting

• (PBSIS-39911) Previously, in StudentInformation v25.0.0, a script was applied that updated the N/A values for Accommodations for the Alternative OELPA test to a value of "NO" if there was a score. Now, a script has been applied that has updated the N/A or null values for Accommodations to "NO" for those records that require "NO."

• (PBSIS-39372) With the removal of SSNs in v25.0.0, the SIS-School Enrollment API calls were failing. These API calls will now succeed because Registration endpoints will allow enrollment and re-enrollment regardless of an SSN. This should work for a brand new student and a student that already exists in the district.
