FY26 Exiting Student Follow Up (Initial) - closes Tuesday, January 6, 2026, at 11:59pm.

ODEW has received the fall college data from the National Clearing House and was able to match that data up, and this information should be reflected in the reports.

Q&A

Q: If we have a ticket for the exiting student follow-up collection that hasn't been resolved, should that just be an appeal the district would do?

A: An appeal would only be if there is something more or different to report that has an impact on Career Tech. If it isn't related to Career Tech, the data doesn't get used now and it can just be resolved during the final window.

Q: This is a JVSD, so it is Career Tech. There was a miscommunication on the SSID with the home school, and there are 2 students who are missing. I believe the correct SSID is being reported, but I will have to review the details.

A: There is a discrepancy between those SSIDs, so we will follow up today. The key thing is to make sure the data is submitted, even if it's under a different SSID. If the student is counted twice, because we're counting it under both the SSID where it was submitted and inserting a non-reported student for the missing SSID, that's the kind of thing that can be cleaned up during the appeal window. We can't change it while the window is still open because the automatic processes will just change it while the window is still open. But we'll get it figured out.

Q: With the CCWMR Received File not being published any longer, can that be documented in the notes, so districts are aware? Currently the "latest version" of these reports in the data collector from November doesn't open correctly. The ODEW EMIS answer has been to open the data in the SDC.

A: Yes, that report has been replaced by the Secure Data Center.
