FY27 EMIS Changes – Quite a few FY27 EMIS Changes were published on ODEW’s website. ODEW is asking districts and ITCs to review those and submit any feedback. These changes will be discussed at OAEP next week and also during the Change Call in a couple of weeks.

Data Collector – The Calendar Collection has been updated to start using the Data Comparison. As a reminder, districts will need to submit this collection. Once ODEW has processed the submission, districts can prepare it again to view the Data Comparison. The Data Comparison has also been turned on for the DN record only in the SOES End of Year Student Collection (2026SBOED). Once the End of Year Student Collection (2026S3TRD) opens on May 1st, districts will also see the Data Comparison for the DN record. ODEW will not enable Data Comparison for any additional record types next week, but will start enabling more the week of May 11th.

In about three weeks, the next Data Collector release will be sent out. This release will enable ITCs to update to the latest version of Java. It doesn’t add any new functionality or enhancements; it is just to update the backend software to make it easier to keep it patched and improve the Data Collector's security posture.

Q&A

Q: On a couple of collections that only process on the weekends, is there a possibility that on the front view of the collection, it says ‘weekend processing’ on those?
