- Understanding of Ohio school finance including budget development while using sound management and fiscal practices;

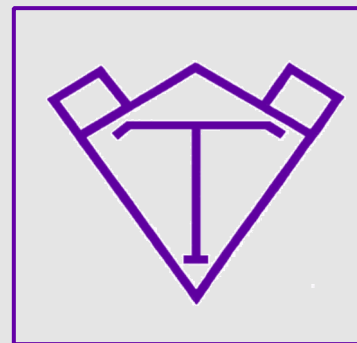
- Willingness to become an active and contributing member of the school community;

About the District

The Triway Local School District is located in southwest Wayne County near the city of Wooster and currently enrolls 1700 students. The Triway District includes three K-6 elementary schools, one intermediate school (7-8) and one high school. The district contains 97 square miles with buses travelling 2000 miles a day.

The Triway Local School District provides a strong academic program with courses ranging from honors/enriched to developmental courses. In addition, high school students have access to the IB Diploma Programme and the College Credit Plus Program off-campus, with several course offerings available in the high school building. Sixty percent of Triway graduates go on to attend college.

High community involvement through PTO's and booster organizations has been a Triway tradition.

About the Community

The Ohio State University Agricultural Technical Institute (ATI) and the Ohio Agricultural Research and Development Center (OARDC) are both located within the district.
