The Board anticipates the new administrator taking office in 2018 with the search assistance of the Putnam County Educational Service Center.

ABOUT THE DISTRICT

The Crestview Local School District is a rural school district covering 128 square miles situated in northwest Ohio in Van Wert County. It is located just off of U.S. Route 30 and approximately halfway between Lima, Ohio and Fort Wayne, Indiana. The district consists of one K-12 building with a total enrollment of 864 students. Vocational students attend Vantage Career Center in Van Wert, Ohio. The district exhibits a strong commitment to providing students with relevant, up-to-date technology including a robust 1:1 computer program. The district is also a committed supporter of co-curricular and extracurricular activities including fine arts, music, service organizations, clubs and athletic teams. Crestview Local Schools offers a well-rounded academic program in a small town setting. The district has earned multiple Excellent school report card ratings and Crestview Elementary School met 8 out of 9 indicators in 2017 while Crestview High School was named in the US Top American High Schools by US News and World Report in 2013 and 2016.
