The district offers a wide range of academic, co-curricular, blended learning, and extra-curricular programs, including an outstanding music program and a very active vocational agricultural program. Background Information

The eighty-three square mile rural setting includes the villages of Cable, Mingo, North Lewisburg, and Woodstock. In 1957 three districts consolidated and a new school was built in a rural location equal distance from each town and renamed Triad. An OSFC project completed in 2002 resulted in a renovated elementary and middle school, along with the construction of a new 9-12 new 9-12 high school.

North Lewisburg is located on State Route 245 between West Liberty and Marysville. Urbana is approximately 15 miles away.
