Nelsonville-York City Schools encompasses approximately 76 square miles, and includes the communities of Nelsonville, Buchtel, Murray City, and Carbon Hill in Athens County and Hocking County. The Nelsonville-York School District is nestled in the Hocking Valley along the Route 33 corridor between Athens and Logan. It is just under a one hour drive to Columbus. The District completed its last building/renovation project in 2010. With the completion of this project our elementary building K-6, junior high 7-8, and high school 9-12 are located on one campus.

Nelsonville-York City Schools has a proud tradition of providing excellent academic opportunities for our students along with several co-curricular and extra-curricular offerings. Hocking College is located within the district and offers an abundance of opportunities for both Nelsonville-York students and adult community members to further their education.

District Information

The district had an ADM of 1215 for the 2017-2018 school year. Full-time staff: 96 certified, 57 classified and 10 administrators. Last year's general fund revenues were 24% from local sources and 76% from the state. Last year's appropriations were \$14,880,000 general fund, \$17,844,000 all funds. The District had outside millage (voted) of 24.0 and \$113,689,260 valuation.
