

Superintendent Search for Mid-East Career and Technology Centers

The Mid-East Career and Technology Centers Board of Education is seeking candidates for the position of Superintendent. The vacancy is created by the retirement of Dr. Richard A. Hall, who has served the District for 5 years. The application deadline is February 14, 2020 and the expected start date is August 1, 2020. The Board of Education has approved Dr. Hall to serve as a consultant to the new Superintendent from August 1, 2020 through September 1, 2020. The applicant must have a valid superintendent license and experience as a school superintendent is preferred.

Qualifications and Responsibilities

The Superintendent is responsible for all operations and is the Chief Executive Officer of the District, including all state and federal reporting, collaborating with the Treasurer in the development of the annual budget, and preparing the Five-Year Forecast. The Superintendent is the facilitator of the District's Administrative Team and will be expected to provide guidance and leadership to the District.

The successful candidate will demonstrate the following:

- A working knowledge of school finance related to operations, construction projects, and program equipment
- Excellent written and verbal skills
- Proven ability to work collaboratively with administrative team
- Strong financial background related to both state and federal grants
- Personal integrity, high standards of honesty, ethics, and personal conduct
- Knowledge and use of software platforms relevant to the Superintendent position
- Willingness to collaborate with other superintendents in the District's service area and region
