Superintendent Search

The Meigs Local School District Board of Education is seeking qualified applicants for the position of superintendent of schools. The vacancy is the result of the pending retirement of the current superintendent, Rusty Bookman, who will have been with the district as superintendent for the past six years.

In addition to providing leadership for all the various programs and operations, the board is seeking an individual who is capable of articulating and achieving the district's educational mission.

About the District

The Meigs Local School District encompasses approximately 200 square miles in the western part of Meigs County. The district includes the Villages of Middleport, Pomeroy, and Rutland. With a total enrollment of 1866 students, the district houses two elementary schools, a middle school, and a comprehensive (academic and career & technical) high school.

The district was the beneficiary of an OSFC program which resulted in the construction of the elementary and middle schools and the complete renovation of the high school.

The district also recently constructed a new athletic field house and a new bus garage/maintenance facility and renovated a former elementary school into a Central Office complex.

The district, which was rated as a high/moderate district with the intermediate and middle school being watch schools on the state report card, is committed to making the necessary improvements to achieve academic success for every child. The district contains one of the unique comprehensive high schools in the State of Ohio in that it offers a complete academic and a complete career and technical offering under one roof. The high school also offers the career and technical programs to the two other high schools in the county.

Meigs Local enjoys a unique relationship with the University of Rio Grande. The university has constructed a branch campus building on the campus of Meigs High School/Meigs Middle School. The goal is to offer college level classes to high school students under the College Credits Plus (CCP) Program without the students having to leave school and drive many miles to get to a college campus. Rio Grande will also offer courses and professional development to educators in the area and in partic-

About the Community

Meigs County is located in Southeastern Ohio approximately 25 miles south of Athens. Meigs County is a family oriented rural area. Residents are employed primarily in farming and industries located outside of the county. The area provides many options for those who enjoy outdoor pursuits including camping, hiking, hunting, fishing, and boating on the Ohio River.

Meigs County has a rich and varied history related to coal mining and the production of salt. Meigs County has the only portion of the Ohio River that flows north as the river makes its way through the county and actually forms the shape of a "boot." Pomeroy, the county seat, is home to one of the

oldest courthouses in Ohio and the only three-story courthouse in America that has a ground-floor entrance on all three floors. Meigs County also is the home of the only Civil War battle to be fought in Ohio when Morgan's Raiders invaded during the war between the states.

The county is within easy driving distance of many other activities. Athens, home of Ohio University, is just north of the county and offers all of the amenities of a mid-major university. Being on the Ohio River, the county also has easy access to the metropolitan areas of Parkersburg, Charleston, and Huntington, West Virginia. Higher education opportunities are available at Ohio University, the University of Rio Grande, West Virginia University at Parkersburg, and Marshall University. Meigs County educators have attended all of these universities with success and pride.

Qualifications

The Meigs Local School District Board of Education is seeking an educational leader whose leadership style encourages broad-based community involvement and support. It is desired that the successful candidate shall reside within Meigs County and become an active member of the community. Prior superintendent experience preferred.
