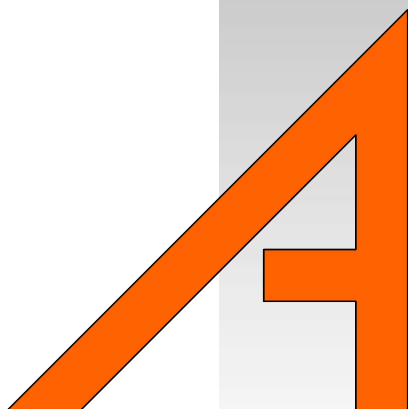

DISTRICT PROGRESS

In November of 2012, our community passed a Bond Issue to replace Ashland Middle School, our two oldest elementary schools and McDowell Auditorium. The Robert M. and Janet L. Archer Auditorium opened on April 19, 2015 and was the perfect compliment for our high school and replaced McDowell Auditorium. In September of 2015, the Ashland City Schools opened Ashland Middle School and Reagan Elementary. The district also enjoys a newly renovated facility that houses our bus garage and administrative offices at a central location. Finally, we are in the process of completing renovations on our high school and two elementary schools. Our new and renovated buildings have the staff, students and community glowing with Arrow pride!
