It is designed to create a linear workflow and process for staff who are tasked with mitigating chronic absenteeism so they spend less time looking at reports, and more time making meaningful contact with the parents.

With AttendanceK12 you can:

- » Automate calculations based on each attendance code and track thresholds without running reports or manual calculations.
- » Track correspondence with parents and guardians and generate meeting summaries and absence intervention plans.
- » Mail letters, send emails and text messages to parents with a single click. No more printing and mailing individual letters to parents.

AttendanceK12 software tracks which students have been already seen, which parents were notified, and what means of communication were used, along with detailed records of all the thresholds met in one central hub. Email, SMS, and mailed letters can be used for the automated means of contact; however, AttendanceK12 can also integrate into other communication tools that a district utilizes (if integration is allowed), such as School Apps or mass notification systems.
